**Scripture Text: Acts 3:6-11**

**Subject: "A Blessing With Your Name On It"**

**Introduction:** As we look at this third chapter of the Acts, a book in the Book of Books, a book many theologians call the Acts of the Holy Spirit, we see a church in full bloom.

Jesus the Christ, the risen Savior, has ascended back into heaven and He is now seated at the right hand of the Father, ever to make intercession for the saints.

Pentecost, the birthday of the church, has already happened.

Peter has preached his first public sermon about salvation available to all through Christ Jesus and over 3000 souls are saved by grace through their faith.

The people of God are fellowshiping and sharing what they have one with another.

And those believers who made up the congregation of that first church are steadfastly praying and praising God together on the regular.

Acts chapter three begins with two believers on their way to church – two broke preachers on their way to God's house seeking a spiritual blessing – yet they stopped outside of the church to take a minute to try and bless someone else.
