Introduction:

- In the text we find a portrait painted by Christ not of a perfect church, but what we see is the potential of a powerful church here on earth.
- In the Acts of the Apostles where we find the first church, we see a group of believers with the
 possibility of greatness, but we also see a group of Christians prone to problems.
- In the Book of Acts we see a church united at times.
- In chapter one, we find the church, these believers were all of one accord.
- In chapter two, the church, these Christians were praying together in one place.
- In chapter four, the church, the believers were of one heart and soul.
- In Acts chapter six, some of these same believers in the church had fallen out with each other.
