Scripture Text: Titus 2:11-14 NLT

Subject: "God's Amazing Grace"

Introduction: Our text this morning comes from one of the Apostle Paul's Pastoral Epistles.

The Pastoral Epistles are a group of three books of the canonical New Testament; these letters are first and second Timothy and Titus.

Two of the most outstanding doctrinal passages in God's inspired Word are found in this letter, one from which our text is taken and the other being Titus chapter three, verses 3 through 7.

These verses talk about the gospel twins grace and mercy.

We might also find it noteworthy that these verses are also notable for their perfect balance of doctrine with everyday living, for these verses set forth both the theory and the practice of Christian living.
