Subject: "Jesus Is The Risen Savior"

Introduction: As we gather here on this Resurrection Sunday it must be noted that the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ next to His birth are the most significant events in the history of mankind to date.

Throughout the world of Christendom believers have come together on this Sunday bowing in humble reverence and with renewed hope in God's plan of salvation through His only begotten Son to set the captives free.

John, chapter 21, is a testimony to the triumph of life over death, love over hate, and hope over despair.

The text before us on this Easter Sunday morning is a profound proclamation of the power found in the resurrection.
