Charles S Wattley Scholarship Program

Purpose

The intent of the Charles S Wattley Scholarship Program is to assist in providing educational assistance to students seeking post-secondary education by promoting funds to future generations of leaders.

The scholarship shall assist with tuition, the purchase of books, lab materials and/or room & board at an accredited college or university.

Eligibility

Each applicant must meet all requirements listed to be eligible:

1. Applicant must attend the College Megafest on October 17, 2026, throughout the duration of the event.
2. Applicant must be a graduating senior at high school or a freshman at an accredited college or university at the time the application is received.
3. Applicant must be accepted in a full-time degree program at an accredited college/university.
4. Applicant must have a minimum overall high school (9th -12th) grade point average of 3.0 in a 4.0 grading system.
5. All applications will need to include proof of ACT or SAT scores.
6. Applicant must attend the church service at 10:45 am on Sunday, October 18, 2026, at 1308 Wilcox Street, McKinney, TX for a presentation honoring all the recipients.

All applicants must provide an intended major.

Unknown or Undecided is not an option.

The application packet contains the following documentation:

1. A completed Charles S Wattley Scholarship Application Form
2. An official high school transcript
3. Proof of current attendance at an accredited college or university (if a college freshman)
4. Two letters of recommendation. The letters may be from a high school teacher on official letterhead and/or a community service organization on official letterhead
5. A 200 – 400-word essay describing how being selected will enhance the candidate's chosen career path

Fill out the scholarship application form accurately and in its entirety. Use additional paper as necessary. Do not write on the back of the application. Read and sign the Applicant's Confirmation, once the application is filled out.
