**Scripture Text: John 19:30 NKJ**

**Subject: "We Have The Victory In Jesus"**

**Introduction:** As we gather once more and again at the place called Calvary, we find the Savior of the world uttering a word of victory.

Seven times the dying Savior spoke. Three of His utterances concerned men – three of His utterances were addressed to God.

And now to the hearing of God and men, angels and Satan, Jesus cries in triumph, **"It is finished."**

As Jesus hung there on that old rugged cross, somewhere between the sixth and the ninth hour – darkness – the still and the sadness of night fell over the land.

But now the darkness of sin has passed – now the darkness of forsakenness has passed.

We turn now from the words of Victim to the words of Victor.
